Joy Ride


*Identifying Our Driving Forces*June 23, 2024

Today we're identifying the forces that drive us, and figuring out what a joy ride is all about!
















For <u>from Him</u> and <u>through Him</u> and <u>to Him</u> are <u>all</u> things. [Therefore] To <u>Him</u> be the <u>glory</u> forever! <u>Amen.</u> – Romans 11:36 NIV



So to seek one's own glory is not glory. – Proverbs 25:27 NKJ



So what's it all about? "HIM"! Magnify Him. Amen? Amen! So why then do I so often tend to make it about magnifying me? Or you, you? Why do we seem to make it about magnifying everything but Him? Mankind is driven to seek a sense of purpose. But we usually begin at the wrong end: our self. Big mistake, because focusing on me prevents me from finding meaning. Know why? Cuz it's not about me! And it only stands to reason, that created beings can only find their reason for being, by seeking their Creator's reason for creating them. So, if we believe in a Creator, that should be our overriding driving desire. Which is why, "to seek one's own glory is not glory". Which is why David said:

When You said [to me], "Seek My face," My heart said to You, "Your face, Lord, I will seek." [And His face was finally found!] – Psalm 27:8 NKJ

For God ... made <u>His light</u> shine in <u>our hearts</u> to give us the <u>light</u> of the knowledge of the glory of God in the <u>face</u> of <u>Christ</u>. – 2 Corinthians 4:6 NIV

And so, it may be all about Him, but it's all because of you. So we need to do an about-face with all our heart. Because, success and fulfillment are very different driving forces. Success comes by attaining what others admire or desire. Whereas, fulfillment comes by attaining your reason for being. So what's driving you? Astronomy made little sense till we realized planets must revolve around the sun! And life is senseless till we realize we must revolve around the Son. Cuz only through Him can we find our true identity and significance and purpose and destiny.



Because, there are only two eternal drivers: God and you; and both are driven by one truly, purely, powerful driving force: love. Which is why you're called to be a driver. When I was 18, pops was away from the wrecking yard when the MV school district called to take bids for two buses. So I offered \$105 apiece. But the next day, they called back to say that I was the only bidder.

And when I went to see 'em, I was told that one was still running. So I wrote a business check for the other, and a personal check for the drivable one. Then I went straight to the DMV, got a bus license booklet, studied it in the parking lot, and went back in and passed the test. Cuz that's all it took back then. Then I went to the old surplus store in Mount Vernon and assembled what looked like a bus driver's uniform. And I drove around that night picking up my friends. And then their friends. I'd pull up to someone's house and honk; and they'd come out and say, "What's going on?" and I'd say, "I got us a bus!" It's very fulfilling to drive others, when your only destination is joy and laughter and love! Which is why you're called to be a driver, to offer others the ride of their life. A joy ride like no other! Which is why a self-centered, self-orbiting life is ultimately empty and unfulfilling, and no life at all. No matter how successful you may or may not become. Because, your Creator wasn't created for you, you were created for Him.

For *You* created my *inmost* being; You knit me together *in* my mother's womb. I praise You because I am fearfully and wonderfully made ... Your eyes *saw* my unformed body. ... How precious to me are Your thoughts, O God! – Psalm 139:13-17 NIV







Were you unplanned? You probably know someone who was. My grandma, whose wedding anniversary was less than nine months before my aunt's birthday, used to say: "First kid only takes 6 months; after that it's the usual 9." If you were unplanned, you were likely treated as a happy accident, a wonderful surprise, or the best mistake we ever made. But it can feel like a nice way of saying you're illegitimate. And maybe you were wounded by that. But, that's what we get if we forget our true Creator. Because He wasn't surprised. So your biologicals didn't plan it; He sure did! He wasn't caught off guard. Way before you were conceived down here, accidentally, intentionally, or howeverly, you were first conceived in our Father's mind and heart. Know why? To express His love. You see, He didn't need you. He chose to create you, because He desires to love you! Know why?

... because God *is* love. [And] This is how God *showed* His love among us: He sent *His* one and only Son into the world that <u>we might live through Him</u>. – 1 John 4:8-9 NIV

[The Father] <u>chose us in Him</u> before the foundation of the <u>world</u> ... In <u>love</u> He <u>predestined</u> us <u>for adoption</u> through Jesus Christ, according to <u>the purpose</u> of <u>His</u> will — Ephesians 1:3-5 ESV

So there's your reason for being! Your true identity is God's child; your significance was set by His death. Your purpose is to drive others to adoption. Because our destiny is to love and be loved eternally. So, we gotta be grounded in His love, as learned from His Word. It's gotta be the driving force at the center of our life. Because, if love doesn't drive us, something else will. Lust. Pride. Jealousy. Deadlines. Painful memories. Take your pick. So what's driving you? And what do you say we take a look at what I think might be our top five driving forces.



The #1 most common driving force has got to be guilt. The ol' skeleton in the closet. So many spend so much life pointlessly running from regret and shame while at the same time hiding it in their heart! Which is why: Guilt-driven people allow the past to control the present. And the future. But:

Blessed is the one whose transgressions are forgiven, whose sins are *covered*. ... When I kept *silent*, my *bones* wasted away [in the *closet*] ... Then I *acknowledged* my *sin* to *You* and did not *cover up* my *iniquity*. ... And You *forgave* the *guilt* of my sin. ... The Lord's *unfailing love* surrounds the one who *trusts* in Him. – Psalm 32:1-5, 10 NIV

There's no question, we are products of our past, but we don't have to be prisoners! Our Heavenly Father is a conscience-clearing phenomenon! That's His specialty. I mean ...

If the blood of bulls and goats ... sanctifies for the purifying of the flesh, [in the OT] how much *more* shall the blood of *Christ*, who ... offered Himself without spot to God, cleanse your conscience from *dead* works to serve the *living* God? – Hebrews 9:13-14 NKJ









And if guilt-driven folks are *first* on the hit list, a close second's gotta be the anger-driven. When you're *overcome* with *anger*, **do you** *clam* **up or** *blow* **up?** I *clam* up, and *clam* up, and *clam* up, and *blow* up! It *resets itself*. Ever said: "I'll *never forgive* them for *what* they *did!*" That's about as dumb as *drinking poison* so *they'll die*. Because, *resentment* is *only deadly* to the *anger-driven fool* doing the *resenting!* Simply put:

Resentment kills a fool – Job 5:2 NIV

That doesn't mean resentment won't kill you if you're smart. It means, no matter how smart you happen to be, you'd be a fool to hold a grudge.

Thus says the Lord, your *Redeemer*, and <u>He who formed</u> you <u>from the womb</u>: "I am the Lord, who makes <u>all</u> things ... and <u>drives [false]</u> <u>diviners mad [See? Even He drives people crazy!]</u> ... and makes their <u>knowledge foolishness; [but]</u> who <u>confirms</u> the <u>Word</u> of His <u>servant</u>, and <u>performs</u> the <u>counsel</u> of His <u>messengers</u>" – Isaiah 44:24-26 NKJ


Another deadly driving force is approval. Because we were designed to need approval. But, from our loving Father. But as we all know, all too well, approval-driven people are controlled by the opinions of others; reducing their quality of life to the likes of a performing seal. So, no matter what the voice inside your head has said, you're not a mistake and you have nothing to prove. So stop preforming. You're not a seal. However you have been sealed. Because:

[God] set <u>His seal of ownership on us</u>, and put His Spirit in our hearts as a deposit, guaranteeing what is to come. – 2 Corinthians 1:22 NIV

And if we don't live in, and live out, His love, we will be driven to seek approval somewhere else, in order to fill that void. But whenever we settle for something less than God, or in addition to God, we end up really resenting the one whose approval we thought we wanted. Because:

No *one* can serve *two* masters. Either he will *hate* the one and *love* the other, or he will be *devoted* to the one and *despise* the other. – Matthew 6:24 NIV

And there's only *One* whose approval is selfless and loving and utterly satisfying. So, we're either seeking that, or some other, much lesser, disappointing source. Which brings us to greed, the driving force of the disappointing source of stuff! Greed-driven people desire to acquire and succeed at any cost – including the cost of our own fulfillment.



We all begin by believing that more money, more power, and more stuff, will make us more satisfied, and more secure, and less afraid. But by our midthirties almost everyone comes to realize that that's not true. So why do we keep living as if it were? Cuz we're driven to make the destructive mistake of connecting self-worth with net worth. Even though, deep down, we all know that our value isn't determined by our valuables. True satisfaction, and significance, and security can only be found in that which can never be taken away. And Jesus couldn't have made His thoughts on this more clear. Saying:

"Life is *more* than *food*, and the body *more* than *clothes*. ... the *pagan* world *runs* after all such things, and your Father *knows* that you *need* them. But <u>seek His kingdom</u>, and *these* things will be *given* to you as *well*. <u>Do not be *afraid*, little *flock*</u>, for your Father has been *pleased* to give you the *kingdom*." – Luke 12:23-32 NIV

And that, little flock, brings us to fear; our final top-five driving force. Fear-driven people are confined and tortured in a self-imposed prison of dread. But isn't it time to break out? Haven't you suffered enough? So escape! Release yourself to the reality of the reason you were created – to be loved and to love – and you'll drive out the driving force of fear. Because, our Father, your Creator, is love, and is perfect, and as you might already know:

Perfect love *drives out fear* – 1 John 4:18 NIV

And guilt, and anger, and approval, and greed. Because perfect love is perfect. But until you see it, and embrace it, and center your daily life around it, you'll allow the force of fear to keep you from becoming the true you, you were created to be. Because you were created to be loved, and to know you're loved, and to be driven by His love. But, that has to begin with Him.

Because *He* himself *gives* all men *life* and *breath* and everything *else* ... God *did* this so that men would <u>seek Him</u> and perhaps <u>reach out for Him</u> and <u>find Him</u>, though He is not far from each *one* of us. 'For <u>in Him</u> we live and move and have our being. – Acts 17:25-28 NIV

And thereby, our reason for being.

Which means there's no such thing as illegitimate children, just illegitimate parents. And that's only because of how they were driven to react to the reality of that situation.

But, for us it's all about Him, because for Him, it's all about us!

Father God, thank You for loving me in spite of my sin; forgive me and cleanse me by the sacrifice of Your Son, my Savior; and free me and lead me by Your Spirit and Word, as I seek to trust and follow Jesus Christ, as the Lord of my life. Amen.
