Fire Works

How to Take a Stand and Shine July 7, 20024

Today we're learning how to take a stand and brightly shine for our Father of lights!



So, first off: Light off any fireworks, and get a dud?



Everyone at your house, sitting in the dark, eagerly waiting for something to do something ... but, it just sits in the dark, disappointing expectations. No burst of glory, lighting up the darkness at your house ... just nothin'. Well, maybe you know that fireworks without fire "works" aren't technically fireworks.



But do you want to know, O foolish man, [or, as the New American Bible translates it: "Do you want proof, you ignoramus"] that faith without [faith] works is [dud, I mean] dead? – James 2:20 NKJ



It isn't that works of faith produce salvation; but that salvation produces shining works of faith. The way a lit lamp or Roman candle produces light. That's our fire "proof" in the dark down here. While under Roman rule:



[John] [the Baptist] was a burning and a shining candle – John 5:35 GNV



[But, when it comes to] The *light* of the *wicked* ... the *spark* of *his fire* shall not *shine*. [So] The *light* shall be *dark* in his *dwelling* – Job 18:5-6 GNV



And on the *hill* above the *Sea*, Jesus told His *freshly appointed*, very *amateur* and *immature*, *apprentices*, the *same* thing He'd tell *us*:

"You are [now] the light of the world." – Matthew 5:14 NIV

Not: should-be, could-be, or will-be; but, ready-or-not: are! "But I fizzle out." But you're the light. "But I'm a punk." So give 'em a light. "But I have a short fuse." But you're the light of the world. "But I thought Jesus said He was the Light of the world." Yes:

He said, "I am the light of the world. [But then added] Whoever follows Me will never walk in darkness, but will have the Light of life [leading them]." – John 8:12 NIV

[And then He added] I must work the works of Him who sent Me ... [And so] As long as I am in the world, I am the light of the world." – John 9:4-5 NKJ

As are we. He projects it and we reflect it – a responsibility, not to be taken lightly; because:

"People [don't] <u>light a lamp</u> and put it <u>under a basket</u>, [that's how you <u>put it out]</u> but [they <u>put it]</u> <u>on a stand</u>, and it <u>gives light</u> to <u>all in</u> the <u>house</u>. In the same way, [take your <u>stand</u>, <u>and fire up your faith</u>, and] let your <u>light shine</u> before <u>others</u>, so <u>that</u> they may <u>see</u> your <u>good works</u> and give <u>glory</u> to your <u>Father</u> who is in <u>heaven</u>." – Matthew 5:14-16 ESV



Because, when "all in the house" see the visible transformation in you, as you reflect more and more of His love, and treat them more and more as He would, they can't help but "Ooh" and "Ahh" at the changes He's causing, sparking the progress you're making. And that's the burning and shining "light" from your fire "works" "stand"!

And that glorifies Him! Shar and I had a dozen firework stands back in the day. And we had one on the main drag at Birch Bay. And we were surprised when the competing stands closed on the night of the 4th, when the police closed the road, and it turned into a giant block party. Great! Then the masses got lubricated and bought fireworks like crazy. Great! And then they started shooting them into our stand, on purpose! Not so great. But, small price for such incredible sales. So I grabbed a garbage can lid as a shield, fended off bottle rockets and Roman candles and completely sold out in a couple hours! Now, Faith-works are like fireworks, because, without faith-works, there's nothing to see. Because, we act on what we trust ... and, we don't act on what we don't trust ... because, we don't trust it! Which is why, James says:

Show me your faith without the works, [which you can't, cuz there's nothin' to see] and I will show you my faith by my works." [Which shines the light of life/growth of the living/growing glory of God] You believe that God is One. [Father. Spirit. Son. Okay] You do well; [But, do realize] the demons also believe, and shudder. — James 2:18-19 NAS

[You see] Demons came out of many people, shouting, "You are the Son of God!" ... Because [by His works, even] they knew He was the Christ. – Luke 4:41 NIV

The prince of darkness is many things, but he ain't an atheist! And if faith was merely a matter of intellectual recognition, even those screamin' demons would be saved! Shar and I actually sold "Screamin' Demons!" And James says we're pretty much neck and neck with 'em till we start to act according to the claims of the One we claim to trust. So pick a team and take a stand!

For it is by grace you have been saved ... to do good works – Ephesians 2:8, 10 NIV

[Cuz] He has made perfect forever those who are being made holy. – Hebrews 10:1-36 NIV







And it's the "being made" that shines the light of life and truth — albeit usually in bursts and flashes. But it lights things up none-the-less. He projects. We reflect. So, are you reflecting what you're receiving in ever-increasing glory? If not, why not? Cuz no one in the house wants a dim wit ... ness; dim witness. Not even unbelievers. And there's no such thing as an undercover light. I was quite the pyro ... technic; or maniac. One of the two. I even had bangs. And back in 1984, I prepared fireworks for a His Place New Year's Eve party. So I got a case of 120, 25-shot, Saturn Missile Batteries, and glued 'em to a piece of plywood, and tucked the fuses into a trail between them, and filled it with black powder. You know, so all 3,000 missiles would shoot off more-or-less simultaneously. Then I gathered the crowd behind the Ark at midnight, and lit 'em. And it went "FOOMP!" and lit 'em all, and blew 'em all off of the plywood in every direction. Here's what I wrote in my journal that night:

"The missile batteries blew apart when the gun powder went off, and they were shooting everywhere ... even into the crowd. People were running and hiding and getting hit. It was very exciting and everyone loved it!" And, I got my hands on Pops' journal and here's all he had to say about it: "Bruce had his fireworks. It went everywhere as usual." Live and learn. Or don't. Choice is ours. But:

Those who are wise will shine like the brightness of the heavens, and those who lead many to righteousness, like the stars for ever and ever. – Daniel 12:3 NIV

[For] Every perfect gift is from above, and comes down from the Father of lights ... [who] brought us [little lights] forth by the Word of Truth ... [Therefore] be doers of the Word ... Anyone who listens to the Word [of Truth] but does not do what it says is like a man who looks at his face in a mirror and ... forgets what he [actually] looks like. – James 1:17-24 NIV

For man is made in God's image and reflects God's glory. - 1 Corinthians 11:7 NLT

Because, we're here to mirror His brilliance in our darkness. Because, to receive is to reflect.

But we *all* ... beholding *as* in a *mirror* the *glory* of the Lord, are *being transformed* into the same *image* from [*dim*] glory to [*bright*] glory – 2 Corinthians 3:16-18 NAS

For now we see in a mirror dimly, but then face to face – 1 Corinthians 13:9-12 NAS

[Because] He is the [projected] image of the invisible God – Colossians 1:15 NAS









You see, projected light (like a movie projector) is measured in lumens. Whereas, reflected light (like a movie screen) is measured in units of gain. How fitting is that, since Paul says, to die to sin is gain! (Phil 1:21) The more reflective the screen, the more lumens are seen. So, how many lumens of grace are you reflecting to all in the house? That depends on how much gain you've gained, from how much sin to which you've died. So, what's consumin' your lumens? Because, holding onto sin is like a screen holding onto filth. Those stains reduce our gains. And:

Anyone who *claims* to be in the *light* but [still] *hates* his *brother* is *still* in the *darkness*. – 1 John 2:9 NIV

[Because] God is light; [and] in Him there is no darkness at all. [So] If we claim to have fellowship with Him yet walk in the darkness, we lie and do not live by the truth. – 1 John 1:5-6 NIV

We're very self-deceiving in acclimating to darkness. What color is that black circle on the screen? Not black. Cuz the screen is white, and projectors only project light. So why does the circle seem so dark? Contrast! Let's make the entire screen the same color as that circle. See? That's what color that circle actually is. The blackness only appears when the surrounding reflected light is intensified, magnified, and let's just say, glorified! You see, without the contrast of light, no one will notice the absence of light. Likewise, we can only see what we're missing when we see what we're missing out on; which is why it's so important that we're reflecting what He's projecting. Because:

The god of this age has *blinded* the *minds* of *unzbelievers*, so that they *cannot see* the *light* of the *Gospel* of the *glory* of *Christ*, who is the *image* of *God*. – 2 Corinthians 4:4 NIV

[So] Let your light shine ... For the glory of the Lord is shining upon you. – Isaiah 60:1 NLT

... that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Isaiah the prophet ... "The people who sat in darkness have seen a great light, and upon those who sat in the region and shadow of death [the] Light [of Life] has dawned." – Matthew 4:14-16 NKJ



Know what the "<u>shadow of death</u>" is? Aging! Our years down here lengthening as we draw ever closer to death's door! As it says in Psalms:

My days are like a shadow that lengthens - Psalm 102:11-12 NKJ

[And] I fade away like an evening shadow – Psalm 109:23 NIV

[Because] In truth, each of us journeys through life like a shadow. ... [So] In light of all this, Lord, what am I really waiting for? You are my hope. – Psalm 39:6 VOICE

In truth, I want to see the light, and be in the light, on that final night! So, want to shine in ways that brings Dad praise? Offer the contrast that only comes from intensifying your reflecting of the light you're receiving, that He's projecting. And don't lie to yourself along the way. To receive is to reflect. Because, light is eagerly emitted from the truly committed. Which is where we, our Father's very amateur, immature, ambassadors come in. Because:

[God] has reconciled us to Himself through Jesus Christ, and has given us the ministry of reconciliation ... [so, ready or not] we are ambassadors for Christ – 2 Corinthians 5:18-20 NKJ

[Jesus said] "I now send you ... to turn them from darkness to light" - Acts 26:17-18 NKJ

[So] Cast off the works of darkness, and ... put on the armor of light. – Romans 13:12 NKJ

For you were once darkness, but now you are light in the Lord. [So] Live as children of light and grow and show your shining works of faith] — Ephesians 5:8-14 NIV

Become *blameless* and *harmless*, children of *God* ... in the *midst* of a *crooked* and *perverse* generation, among *whom* you *shine* as *lights* – Philippians 2:15-16 NKJ

"What's that? You'd like to know why I've stopped dropping the "F" bomb? And how I seem to have more peace and hope when all hell breaks loose? Well, allow me to shed some light!" At the end of the day, everyone longs to escape the darkness of sin, from without and within. Because, this ol' world has a fatal heart condition: it's filled with darkness. And, God sends His lumens through us flawed humans. Cuz we're done for unless we can get a peace-maker implanted before it's too late. So, don't just pray for peace, make peace with all in your house. And shine your light, by reflecting His love, in ever-increasing measure. Because, ready or not, like it or not, you are His amateur, immature, ambassador! So, take a stand, and live like a child of the Father of lights; and simply do what you trust to be true, and your faith will grow ... like a fireworks show!

And let's show this ol' world just what they've been missing!

Father God, thank You for loving me in spite of my sin; forgive me and cleanse me by the sacrifice of Your Son, my Savior; and free me and lead me by Your Spirit and Word, as I seek to trust and follow Jesus Christ, as the Lord of my life. Amen.
